### Minutes January, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm.

The Treasurer's report was read and accepted.

#### **Correspondence:**

#### **Old Business:**

Rob advised he researched insurance for the swap meet to meet new 1 million dollar coverage requirement of the new Toledo High School principal. AMA will cover the swap meet if the club requests a "Dated Certificate" at a cost of \$20. This provides the same 2.5 million dollar coverage provided to Mrs. Herren for Herren Field, but is only valid for the one day at the High School. It was voted to request the "Dated Certificate" with the 2011 club charter renewal.

Rob reported the new club decals were picked up and it was discovered there was a printing error with some colors being transparent. This caused colors to change when placed on surfaces other than white. The printer is fixing them and we should have them soon.

#### **New Business:**

Discussions occurred about Herren Field maintenance. It was decided the tables, field and sani-can were in good shape. Alan volunteered to spray for weeds and it was decided against applying moss killer / fertilizer this season. There was concern that some of the safety fencing needs replacing. Further evaluation will occur at the May work party.

Horty brought up instructors for new pilots. There was much discussion about liability and that instructors should be volunteers, not assigned, and that a process be used to ensure the instructor is qualified. Rob suggested following the AMA Introductory Pilot Program guidelines if instructors are going to be formally identified.

Horty reported Bill Martin gave him some plans for a foamy Tiger Cat.
