Minutes December, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Dick Anderson.

Minutes from the November 2011 meeting were accepted as published.

The Treasurer's report was read and accepted.

Correspondence:

AMA Charter renewal reminder – expires March 31, 2012. Washington State Non-Profit renewal reminder also expires March 31, 2012. A request was received from the Secretary of State to determine if club was required to register for the Charities Program. After reviewing the flow chart, the Secretary determined we do not.

Old Business:

PIN Board Project – Several ideas were presented about a new option Alan first presented. After much discussion, it was voted and approved for a new design. The design will be a simple thin board that will be attached vertically to the existing club information / AMA rules board. The PIN Board will have horizontal lines painted from top to bottom designating each channel number. Pilots will be required to provide their own channel number clothes pin to clip on the corresponding channel line they will be using. For larger events, such as Fly-Ins, the existing club owned channel pins will be utilized. Dick Albright and the Victor's agreed to work on the new design and hope to show their progress at the January meeting.

Warbird Fly-In - Discussions occurred about the previous idea of a club sponsored War Bird Fly-In. It was mentioned that the Cowlitz club only had two flyers show and the Clark County club also had a low turn out at both of their War Bird Fly-Ins. It was decided to have a War Bird only flight at the Summer Fly-In in lieu of a dedicated War Bird Fly-In. Motion made by Horty and passed. The definition of a War Bird will be made later.

Earle Erdman Memorial Brick - The Secretary asked for clarification of the wording the club would like engraved on the AMA Walk Of Fame memorial brick the club will purchase in memory of Earle. It was decided to engrave his name on the top line and the bottom line would state LCRC 1972-2011 in honor of his years of service to the club.

Earle Erdman Remembrance - Horty received the OK from his boss to host the event at their warehouse in Chehalis. The warehouse is located at 2108 Jackson Hwy, across from the entrance to the District 6 Fire Station near the intersection of Jackson Hwy and SW 21st Street just south of the City of Chehalis. A map will be posted on the club web site on the Remembrance of Earle Erdman page.

The date of the Remembrance will be Saturday, January 14th, 2011 from 10am to 2pm. There will be a "no-grill" style potluck lunch. Please bring a pre-cooked or snack type dish. We will share stories, memories, pictures and projects of Earle. Earle's RC collection will be on display and given away at noon. Current LCRC members (2012 dues paid) will receive a free raffle ticket upon arrival. At noon we will begin the raffle. As each ticket is drawn, the winner will pick an item. After all tickets are drawn, they will be returned to the can and drawn again until all of the collection is gone. We felt this gives everyone an equal chance at the items and makes it a fun way to fulfill his family's request. More details are posted on the club web site on the Remembrance of Earle Erdman page.

Club Officers Election - The current club officers were the only nominees from the November club meeting. It was voted and passed to re-elect the current club officers.

New Business:
